

RESOLUTION # 15-06

WHEREAS, the Town of Eva is aware that the Alabama Department of Economic and Community Affairs (ADECA) has made federal funds available through the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program, and;

WHEREAS, the Town of Eva is sensitive to the urgent need for emergency repairs to our wastewater treatment plant, and;

WHEREAS, the Town of Eva proposes a project to address the current need by constructing a new reinforced concrete primary septic tank along with a new effluent dosing pump station, and;

WHEREAS, the total project cost is estimated to be \$134,625.00 and the Town of Eva is requesting \$75,000.00 in CDBG Funds provided by the ADECA and will provide the matching cash funds in the amount of \$59,625.00 for the project.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Council of the Town of Eva, Alabama, authorizes the Mayor to sign all related documents and assurances related to this project.

PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

The Town of Eva will hold a public hearing on September 15, 2015, 5:00 p.m. at Town Hall to discuss the town's submission of an urgent need application for the Fiscal Year 2015 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program. As part of the hearing process citizens will be asked to verbally comment on the proposed project. The town needs as much local participation as possible in order to reflect the true desires of the community as a whole, as well as the comments relating to the proposed project application. The State has established a maximum application request for each funding category. Activities that are eligible for funding include the improvement of public works, public facilities, housing rehabilitation, and others allowed by law. No displacement of persons is proposed.

The town is proposing to install a new reinforced concrete primary septic tank along with a new effluent dosing pump to correct a leak at the wastewater treatment that is a threat to the public's health, safety, and welfare. The proposed project area is located at 99 Murphrees Road SE, Eva, AL, 35621. The total project cost is estimated at \$134,625.00. The town will be required to contribute local matching funds in the amount of approximately \$59,625.00. The project, if funded, will directly benefit all sewer customers in the Town of Eva, including any low- and moderate-income persons, and meet the urgent community need that is posing a serious and immediate threat to the health and welfare of the community, while creating a suitable living environment. All citizens are encouraged to attend in order to comment on the proposed activities.
