Resolution Concerning Junior College

at Hanceville, Alabama

WHEREAS the enrollment at Wallace State Community College has outgrown the physical facilities since during the last five years the enrollment has grown from 200 to over 2,000 with half of these students enrolled in the Junior College Division, and

WHEREAS no money has been appropriated for classroom facilities since the Junior College was begun. The students deserve better service than can be provided under these conditions, and


WHEREAS the area served by this institution is becoming industrialized and has a rapid increase in population which indicates the enrollment will continue to double annually for the next three or four years, and




