

Minutes of the meeting of the Mayor and Council of the Town of Eva held in regular session at 7 p.m. on April 12, 1979, with the Mayor and all 5 councilmen present.

Minutes of the March 9 meeting were read and approved. Financial report was given, and accepted as presented. Copy is attached for the records.

Two applicants for the CETA supervisory position were discussed, and it was decided by the Mayor and Council to hire Carol Newman. Mrs. Holmes will work out details with NARCOG and the employment office.

The Mayor read correspondence of the Town of Eva.

The population was discussed briefly, touching on the information contained in the Morgan County Health Council report which shows that during the 1970 Census there were 3540 in the Eva Census Division. It is estimated that the 1980 Census will show an increase of at least 3000 in the Eva Census Division, and that the aged percentage will increase from 9.7 to about 12%.
