

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF EVA, ALABAMA, HELD ON APRIL 9, 1964.

The Mayor and Council of the Town of Eva, Alabama, held their regular meeting on April 9, 1964, at the school in the Town of Eva, Alabama, at 7:00 P.M.

The Mayor called the meeting to order and ask the Town Clerk to call the roll. All members of the Town's governing body, consisting of the Mayor and five Councilmen, were present for this meeting. The Mayor ask the Town Clerk to read the minutes of the previous meeting. After the reading of the minutes, the Mayor ask if there were any corrections to be made in the minutes. There were no corrections to be made so the Mayor declared the minutes approved as read.

The Mayor then ask for reports from any committees. There were no committees present to give any reports.

The Mayor then ask for other information that should be brought before the Council relating to resolutions, ordinances, orders, and other business. There were no ordinances presented for consideration at this meeting. The Mayor then read a letter from Mr. Albert Brewer, City Attorney, regarding license for salesmen and repair men who do business in the Town of Eva, Alabama. The letter stated that they were supposed to purchase a license. Next, the possibility of erecting city limit signs for the Town of Eva was discussed. Councilman Higgs was instructed to check with the Town of Vinemont, Alabama, to see how their city limit signs were made.

The Mayor then brought up the idea of the Town of ^vEva joining the Falkville Fire Department so our Town could get fire protection service from Falkville in the event of a fire in the city limits. After the discussion the Mayor was ask to investigate the matter further.

The Town Clerk was instructed to send to the League of Municipality in Montgomery a list of the Town's officials and the date of the incorporation of the Town.

The Town Clerk presented to the Council one bill for consideration. This bill was for \$18 and was owed to ~~Office Equipment~~ ^{Modernistic} ~~Co.~~ ^{Printers, Inc.} for letterhead stationery and envelopes for the Town. Councilman Oden made a motion instructing Town Clerk to pay the bill mentioned above. This motion was seconded by Councilman McDonald.

There being no further business to come before the Council, the same was, on motion, duly ajourned.
