

THE MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF EVA, ALABAMA HELD ON APRIL 14, 1966.

The Council held their regular meeting on April 14, 1966 at the School in the Town of Eva, at 7:00 P.M.

Mayor Ryan called the meeting to order and ask the Clerk to call the roll. All members were present. The Mayor ask for the minutes of the last meeting to be read. There being no corrections, the minutes were approved as read.

The Mayor ask for any reports or any other business to come before the Council. Councilman Hipps reported on the project of getting water from the City of Cullman, he talked with a Councilman from Cullman who sounded very favorable toward the idea. Mayor Ryan suggested that a letter be written to the Alabama Alcoholic Beverage Control Board concerning their letter of April 1, 1966 that we were supposed to receive A.B.C. store profits twice each year. We have not received any of these as yet. Councilman Patton made the motion to send the letter. The motion was second by Councilman Livingston. All members voted in favor.

There was discission on the possibility of a part time Law Officer to work in Eva.

A proclamation was received from the Boy Scouts of America concerning a \$350,000,000 Camp Expansion for the Tennessee Valley, it was endorsed by the Mayor and Councilman.
