

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF EVA,  
ALABAMA, HELD ON APRIL 11, 1968.

The Mayor and Council of the Town of Eva, Alabama held their regular meeting in the school on the 11th day of April with the Mayor and all the council present.

Mayor Ryan called the meeting to order and called for the minutes of the last regular meeting read. The minutes were read and approved.

A motion carried for the clerk to order personalized checks for the City. This is in accordance with new requirements by all banks. A book for 500 checks will cost \$6.11, of which a check is to be written for this amount.

Mayor Ryan gave a report on a Food Stamp Program, backed by the county and all cities in the county. This program is in accordance with and will be backed by either the state or the Federal Government, with aid from the participating cities. A general discussion was had concerning this program and was agreed by the council by a move and second for the city to accept it's share of the cost, if when the amount was received, it is within the range of the city's funds.

There was a report from Mayor Ryan concerning the gargage disposal system for the county. It is being discussed over the county for some suitable plan for county wide service.

Councilman McDonald brought before the council a proposal for borrowing money for the purpose of building a town hall and fire station. The discussion was tabled for further reference.

A move and second was made to adjourn until the next regular meeting.
