

THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF EVA,  
ALABAMA, APRIL 2, 1970

The mayor and council met at 7:30 p.m. in the Town of Eva, Alabama, on April 2, 1970 for their April meeting.

Several plans and/or proposals for improvements to city property and streets were introduced. The council discussed plans and examined diagrams for lighting the city streets. After deliberation, a motion was made by Councilman Patton and seconded by Councilman McDonald to suspend rules and they unanimously decided to accept Joe Wheeler Coop's proposal to erect and maintain lights in the city limits.

There was a motion and it carried to continue insurance on fire truck. The clerk was instructed to write a check for premium of \$74.10.

The clerk was given \$10.00 received from Howard Patton for a fire call. The clerk also received instruction to send statements to Glen Johnson, Route 7, Cullman, Ala.; Will Wright, Route 2 Vinemont, Alabama for fire calls.

Communications were received from the State of Alabama about information on social security coverage for city employees. Since none are paid, no action was taken.

There was a short discussion on improving, or helping the churches improve the cemetery in the city. The matter was tabled for further investigation.

A move and second was made to adjourn.
