

THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF EVA,
ALABAMA ON APRIL 8, 1971

The mayor and council met in Councilman Patton's service station for their regular meeting on April 8, 1971 at 7:00 p.m. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Ryan, the roll call was had and all the councilmen were present.

Several bids for insurance on the City Hall building were introduced. After discussion of bids of \$200.00 from Fowler Ins. Co., \$59.00 from State Farm, and no definite figure from Farm Bureau, it was decided to buy State Farm. The move was made by R. L. Livingston and seconded by Claude Patton to take the policy with a "Loss Payable Clause" to the State National Bank of Falkville. The move carried and was so ordered.

Bills for \$2.05 for recording fee to the State National Bank, and \$155.48 for 650 8" blocks to Stephen Building Supply, Hartselle, Ala., was presented. After discussion, a move was made, seconded, and carried for the bids to be allowed and ordered paid.

After a general discussion of the progress of the City Hall Building, it was determined that there was no further business to come before this meeting.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
