

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF
EVA, ALABAMA, HELD ON AUGUST 13, 1964.

The Mayor and Council of the town of Eva, Alabama held their regular meeting on August 13, 1964, at the school in the town of Eva, Alabama at 7:00 P.M.

The Mayor called the meeting to order and ask the town clerk to call the roll. All members of the Town's governing body, consisting of the Mayor and five Councilmen, were present for the meeting. The Mayor then ask the town clerk to read the minutes of the previous meeting. There were no corrections to be made in the minutes, so the Mayor declared the minutes approved as read.

The Mayor then ask for reports from any committees. Councilman McDonald, Chairman of the Streets, Parks and Cemetery committee, reported that he had been unable to contact Mr. Nelson about the signs needed for the streets.

The Mayor then ask for other information that should be brought before the Council relating to resolutions, ordinances, orders and other business. There were no ordinances or resolutions presented for consideration at this meeting.

A letter was read by the Mayor, from Mr. Albert Brewer, concerning delinquent privilege license.

The Mayor presented a bill from Mr. C.C. Acker, for the amount of \$25.00, for auditing the town books and preparing a ~~*****~~ financial statement for the town. A motion was made by Councilman Oden, that the clerk be authorized to pay this bill to Mr. Acker (\$25.00) The motion was seconded by Councilman McDonald. All members voted in favor of this motion.
