

THE MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF
EVA, ALABAMA, HELD ON AUGUST 12, 1965.

The Council of the Town of Eva, Alabama held their regular meeting on August 12, 1965, at the School in the town of Eva, Alabama, at 7:00 P.M.

Mayor Ryan called the meeting to order and ask the Clerk to call the roll. All members were present. The Mayor ask that the minutes of the last meeting be read. This was the meeting of June 29, 1965 (a called meeting). No meeting was held during the month of July. There were no corrections of the minutes read, they were approved as read.

Mayor Ryan ask for any reports from committees or other business to come before the Council. The Clerk was authorized to pay the following bills. \$7.50 to Frazer Machine and Supply Co. for electrical supplies, ~~\$21.25~~ \$21.25 to Howard Millwood for electric membership, supplies and labor on traffic light, \$10.00 to Rankin Insurance Agency for bond on Clerk.

There was a discussion on the water for the town. Mayor Ryan reported that the geologist had been out to look the area over. He had said that plenty of water should be found in the area south of the school. Mayor Ryan offer ^{ED} to let a test well be drilled on a portion of his property (south ^{west} east of his dam and lake) Then if sufficient water was found, to give the Town an easement for the use of the property to drill wells to furnish the town with water.

Councilman Oden made a motion to drill the well, Councilman Patton second the motion. All members voted in favor. Councilman Patton is to see Mr. Leon Miller about doing the drilling.

There being no further business to come before the Council, the same was, on motion, duly ajourned.
