

Minutes of the meeting of the Town Council of Eva held in regular session at 7 p.m. on August 9, 1979, attended by the Mayor and the following members of the Council: Alton Page, Jimmy Mosteller and Ray Morgan.

Minutes of the July 12 meeting were read and approved. A financial report, giving end of July totals, was presented as follows:

General Fund	\$162.11 (+ \$2000 certificate of deposit)
Gasoline Tax Fund	\$172.23
Revenue Sharing	\$1172.76
Volunteer Fire Dept.	\$989.46

After discussion of the amount in the general fund, Mr. Morgan offered the motion that we cash the Certificate of Deposit, and put \$500 into the General Fund and reinvest the remaining \$1500. Motion seconded by Mr. Page carried.

The forthcoming Physicians Opportunity Fair was briefly discussed. Mr. Page said that he would not be able to go this year since his baby will be due at the time of the Fair.

The Mayor invited Council Members to accompany him to the Mayor's meeting to be held in Huntsville on the coming Thursday night, at which time Howell Heflin will speak. Members are to let him know if they will be able to go.

The School Situation was discussed. The Mayor said that we should keep abreast of the situation and if we feel there is something we can do, we could have a call meeting.

Mr. Page offered the motion to pay the bills, listed below; seconded by Mr. Mosteller:

The Mayor read over the incoming letters and the July Report on the Elderly Survey. A total of 70 people were surveyed in the Ryan area in July, of whom 25 were over age 70. Forms were filled out requesting help for 5 families (2 for home weatherization and 3 for food stamps). Some of the letters of particular note were: Letter from the Jerry Lewis Muscular Dystrophy Telethon; Letter from State Dept. of Public Health concerning Section 22-20-5 of the Code of Ala.; Letter from NARCOG about the 1980 Census; Letter from the North Ala. Health Systems Agency on the medical assessment forms for Morgan County. The Mayor said that he had filled out a questionnaire about the needs for Eva and sent it back to NAHSA. He also read excerpts from the letter from Ala. Academy of Family Practices. It was decided that we send them a letter about the need for a physician in Eva. The Mayor also mentioned that we might write to TVA whether they have a list of doctors who might be available. There was a letter from the State Farm Bureau in Montgomery sending a \$2 check for inquiring about an accident report. The clerk will fill out the form and return it to Montgomery, telling them that we have no police records here. The \$2 check will be deposited in the Town of Eva account.

There being no further business, Mr. Page offered the motion that the meeting adjourn.
