

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF EVA ALABAMA, HELD ON DECEMBER 10, 1964.

The Mayor and Council of the town of Eva, Alabama held their regular meeting on December 10, 1964, at the school in the town of Eva, Alabama at 7:00 P.M.

The Mayor called the meeting to order and ask the town clerk to call the roll. All members of the towns governing body, consisting of the Mayor and five Councilmen, were present. The Mayor ask the town clerk to read the minutes of the last meeting held. There being no corrections of the minutes, the Mayor declared the minutes approved as read.

The Mayor then ask for reports from any committees. Councilman Oden reported that he had not been able to contact Judge Almon, about the funds the town should receive from the state.

There was further discussion on the caution light for the main intersection of the highways in the town. Councilmen Oden and Livingston are to contact Judge Almon and Guy Roberts about the funds from the state and the taxes for upkeep of the streets and roads and the caution light for the intersection.
