

MINUTES OF A CALLED MEETING OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF
EVA, ALABAMA, HELD ON DECEMBER 29, 1964

The Mayor and Council of the Town of Eva, held a called meeting on December 29, 1964, at the School in the Town of Eva, Alabama at 7:00 P.M.

The Mayor called the meeting to order and ask the Clerk to call the roll. All members of the Towns governing body were present. The Mayor then ask the Clerk to read the minutes of the last meeting held. There being no corrections, the Mayor declared the minutes approved as read.

The Mayor then ask for reports from any committees. Councilman Oden, Chairman of the Finance Committee, reported that he had contacted Judge Alman, concerning any funds from the State, that the Town should be receiving. Judge Almon, said he was not well enough informed on that subject, to give Mr. Oden any information.

Councilman Livingston, of the Streets, Parks and Cemetery Committee, reported that he had been to Decatur to talk with Mr. Guy Roberts of the Morgan County Board of Revenue, aboute the signs for the streets and the caution light for the main intersection of the highways. Mr. Roberts was out at that time and his secretary could not give Mr. Livingston any information. Mr. Ryan, the Mayor, said he would try to see Mr. Roberts, about the funds, signs and light.

The Mayor, ask for any other information ~~that~~ should be brought before the Council, relating to resolutions, ordanances, orders and other business. There were no ordinances presented for consideration at this meeting.

The Clerk presented a bill from Rankin Insurance Agency, for the amount of \$10.00 due on the \$1000.00 bond on the Town Clerk. Councilman Patton made a motion that the Clerk be authorized to pay the bill, \$10.00 to the Rankin Insurance Agency. The motion was seconded by Councilman McDonald. All members present voted in favor of the motion.

A motion was made by Councilman Hipps to authorize the Clerk to purchase a \$5.00 roll of postage stamps and spend \$2.45 for typing paper and a rubber stamp (TOWN OF EVA). The motion was seconded by Councilman McDonald. All members present voted in favor of the Motion.

There was a discussion on collecting the Town License fees. A decision was made to send statements at the present time.

There being no further business to come before the Council, the same was, on motion, duly ajourned.
