

REGULAR MEETING OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF EVA, ALABAMA,  
ON DECEMBER 11, 1969

The mayor and council held their regular meeting December 11, 1969 in the town of Eva, Alabama, in Councilman Patton's Service Station at 7:30 p.m. Mayor Ryan called the meeting to order and ordered a roll call. All councilmen were present.

Under the head of regular business, Councilman Patton presented the gasoline and service bill for the fire truck in the amount of \$28.75. This bill was for a five month period. There was a regular move and second that the bill be ordered and allowed paid. The motion carried unanimously.

The clerk presented a statement received from the State National Bank of Falkville in the amount of \$500.00 for the balance of our note on the fire truck. After a generalized discussion, it was moved, seconded, and carried that we pay one half plus interest and renew the balance for a one month period.

Mayor Ryan presented a CULLMAN TIMES paper for the councilmen to read an article on the progress of the city's water system.

The clerk was instructed to send a fire call bill to Jerry C. Dye and Mrs. Agnus Scott and request payment.

There was a move and second that the meeting adjourn.
