

THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF EVA,  
ALABAMA, DECEMBER 10, 1970

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Ryan. A roll call was called for and all councilmen were found present.

The major matter on the agenda was the discussion of plans for and decisions for the City Hall building. There is no architectural drawing for the building. The council discussed plans for size, design, and material. It was agreed that the general agreement of the mayor and council would be the final plans for the building and that any change would be agreed upon before changes would be made. The building will be built according to the attached sketch.

A bill from Valley Oil Company in the amount of \$72.56 for repair on the fire truck was presented. It was moved and seconded that it be allowed paid. Also a bill for the amount of \$25.00 for back hoe work on foundation for the City Hall was moved to be allowed paid. Both bills were ordered and allowed paid.

After a very detailed discussion of the building plans on the City Hall and other generalized items of business, it was regularly moved and seconded that the meeting adjourn until our next regular meeting or until a special meeting if need be called. Motion carried.
