The Town Council of the Town of Eva, Alabama held their regular meeting in the town hall at 7:00 p.m.

Mayor Ryan called for the reading of the minutes of the last regular communication. They were read and approved.

A discussion of the delinquent reports to the revenue sharing was had and all reports were brought up to date.

A bill for \$9.90 to The Cullman Tribune for advertisement of the planned revenue sharing was ordered and allowed paid. Also a bill for payment of miscellaneous bills to Miner Grocery be allowed paid. A bill to Joe Hill Texaco service station for gas bill of \$37.44 be allowed paid.

The mayor and council checked and approved the bank balance of the city's three bank accounts.

It was also agreed that the city purchase fire fighting equipment and use the revenue sharing fund for payment. A bill for \$108.10 for two costs and one pair Knee boots.

After a general discussion of various around the town projects and happenings the meeting was adjourned.
