

February 7, 1974

The Town Council of the town of Eva, Alabama held their regular meeting in the town hall in the town of Eva, Alabama on the 7th day of Feb. 1974.

Mayor Ryan called for the reading of the minutes of the last communication. They were accordingly read and approved.

The following bills were presented for the councils consideration:

1. Insurance on 52 G.M.C. Fire truck--\$80.70. It was voted to pay this bill out of the revenue sharing fund.
2. Balance on note and Interest on Building loan of \$5500.00. The council voted to pay \$1000.00 principal and \$357.50 interest.
3. Harry Harless Company Inc., \$108.10 for fire coats and boots was presented for payment. It was agreed for the payment to be made and to come from revenue sharing fund.
4. League of municipalities assements of \$82.61. Councilman McDonald made a motion and seconded by councilman Livingston that we pay \$25.00. The motion carried.
5. North Alabama Mayors Association annual dues \$50.00. Councilman Smith made a motion that the dues be paid. The motion was seconded by councilman Patton. The motion carried.

There was a general discussion on the proposed water system for the city. The discussion was concerning the consideration the system had shown the city of Eva as to the number and location of the fire plugs, if any, was planned for the city. It was agreed to wait until the contracts was let and we knew more about the details before we discussed the issue further.

A motion was made to buy new hose for the city of Eva fire truck and use the revenue sharing fund an payment.

The meeting was adjourned.
