

Feb. 12, 1976

The regular meeting of the mayor and council of the town of Eva, Ala. was held in the town hall on Thursday Feb. 12, 1976 at 7:00 P.M.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Ryan, with councilmen Mitchell Hipps, Terrell Livingston, and Claud Patton present.

Minutes of last month's meeting was read by Mayor Ryan and approved by the councilmen present.

Mayor Ryan gave the financial report as:

Service station owners had been asked to attend the town meeting. Those present were Benny Childers, Auburn Ryan, Maurice Bentley, Bill Neal. Mayor Ryan and the councilmen wanted to talk to those present how it would affect their gas sales if a one cent or one half cent tax was put on gas. He explained this money was needed for paying the light bill on city street lights. Each one attending gave different ways in which they asked if the money could come from another source. Mayor Ryan said he would check other sources so the matter of gas tax was tabled until a later meeting. Mr. Bentley thanked the town members for asking them to attend the meeting.

Mayor Ryan told the councilmen that the ladies of the Eva Activity Association had asked for the use of the town hall for a place to meet for different classes they were to have. Terrell Livingston made the motion to let them use the building and this was seconded by Claud Patton.

Mitchell Hipps made a motion to have enough funds transferred from the General Fund to pay the light bill on city street lights. This motion was seconded by Claud Patton.

Mayor Ryan said an audit of the town books would be made on February 24.

Meeting was adjourned until next month.
