

The Mayor and Council of the Town of Eva met on February 28, 1977. This was a called meeting.

Meeting was called to order by Mayor Ryan. The first order of business was to fill the vacancy on council left open by the moving of Bill Neal. Donald Ray Morgan was appointed to serve on council to fill this vacancy. The next order of business was to decide on a new truck for the fire dept. After discussion, let it be resolved that the attending council of Eva does here by agree to purchase a new truck to replace No. 1 fire truck which is approximately 27 years old. Bids had been received. Mayor Ryan told the council that Central Bank at Falkville had agreed to let the town have money to purchase the new fire truck. The bids are as follows:
