

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF  
EVA, ALABAMA, HELD ON JANUARY 9, 1964.

The Mayor and Council of the Town of Eva, Alabama, held their regular meeting on January 9, 1964, at the school in the Town of Eva, Alabama, at 7:00 P.M.

The Mayor called the meeting to order and ask the Town Clerk to call the roll. All members of the governing body, consisting of the Mayor and five councilmen, were present for this meeting. The Mayor ask the Town Clerk to read the minutes of the previous meeting. After the reading of the minutes, the Mayor ask if there were any corrections to be made in the minutes. There were no corrections, so the Mayor declared the minutes approved as read.

The Mayor then ask for reports of any committees. There were no committees present to give any reports.

The Mayor then ask for any ordinances that should be brought before the Council. Councilman Patton moved that the Council adopt Ordinance No. 4, which is as follows and which was introduced at the regular meeting held on December 12, 1963. This move was seconded by Councilman Oden.

The Mayor then ask if there were any other information to be presented to the Council. The Town Clerk presented two bills, one for \$10.00, owed to Rankin Insurance Agency; for the Town Clerk's bond; and the other for \$50.00, owed to V. H. Padgett Associates for drawing map of the town of Eva. Councilman Patton made a motion that Town Clerk pay the two bills mentioned above, This was seconded by Councilman McDonald. All members of the Council voted in favor of the motion.

Councilman Oden then made a motion that the Town Clerk be given authority to buy stamps and supplies necessary to carry out Privilege License Ordinance. This motion was seconded by Councilman Hipps. All members of the Council voted in favor of the motion.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, the same was, on motion, duly ajourned.

# AN ORDINANCE #4

Authorizing the Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company to use the public streets of the Town of Eva, Alabama, for the purpose of erecting, constructing, maintaining and operating lines of telephone and telegraph thereon and thereunder.

SECTION 1. Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Eva, Alabama, that permission be and the same is hereby granted to the Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company, its successors and assigns, to construct, maintain and operate lines of telephone and telegraph, including the necessary poles, conduits, cables, fixtures and electrical conductors upon, along, under and over the public roads, streets and highways of the Town of Eva, Alabama, as its business may from time to time require, provided that all poles shall be neat and symmetrical.

SECTION 2. The work of erecting poles and constructing underground conduits under this ordinance shall be done subject to the supervision of the Town, and the Company shall replace or properly relay and repair any sidewalk or street that may be displaced by reason of such work, and upon failure of the Company so to do, after twenty days' notice in writing shall have been given by the Mayor of the Town to the Company, the Town may repair such portion of the sidewalk or street that may have been disturbed by the Company, and collect the cost so incurred from the Company.

SECTION 3. In consideration of the rights and privileges herein granted, the Company, when requested by the Town, will designate and provide without cost to the Town (1) on each pole owned and used by the Company hereunder and during its ownership and use thereof, either (a) space for a fixture for, or (b) space for a cross-arm for, wires of the police and fire alarm signalling system of the Town, and (2) in each underground conduit owned and used by the Company hereunder and during its ownership and use thereof, one duct for the cables of the police and fire alarm signalling system of the Town; provided, however, that no use shall be made by the Town of said space on such poles or of said duct which will result in interfering with or impairing the operation or use of the Company's property or service, or which will endanger, damage or injure the person or property of the public or employees of the Company or Town.

SECTION 4. The Company shall indemnify the Town against, and assume all liabilities for, damages which may arise or accrue to the Town for any injury to persons or property from the doing of any work herein authorized, or the neglect of the Company or any of its employees to comply with any ordinance regulating the use of the streets of the Town, and the acceptance by the Company of this ordinance shall be an agreement by it to pay to the Town any sum of money for which the Town may become liable from or by reason of such injury.

SECTION 5. The Company shall file with the Town Clerk of the Town its acceptance of this ordinance within sixty days from the date when it shall take effect.

SECTION 6. Nothing in this ordinance shall be construed as a surrender by the Town of its rights or power to pass ordinances regulating the use of its streets.

SECTION 7. This ordinance shall be in force from and after the date of its passage and publication as required by law.

Introduced and read at meeting of Town Council of said Town held on the 12th day of December, 1963.

Read and finally passed at regular meeting of Town Council of said Town held on the 9th day of January, 1964.
