

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF EVA,
ALABAMA, HELD ON JANUARY 14, 1965

The Mayor and Council of the Town of Eva, Alabama held their regular meeting on January 14, 1965, at the School in the Town of Eva, Alabama at 7:00 P.M.

The Mayor called the meeting to order and ask the clerk to call the roll. All members of the Council were present except Councilman R.L. Livingston. The Mayor ask that the minutes of the last meeting held, be read. There being no corrections, the minutes were declared approved as read.

The Mayor ask for reports from any committees. There were no reports from any of the committees.

The Mayor ask for any other information that should be brought before the council, relating to resolutions, ordinances, orders and other business. There were no ordinances presented for consideration at this meeting.

Mr. Ryan, the Mayor, reported that he did not see Mr. Guy Roberts, about the Caution light and signs. There was a discussion about the light, might be furnished by the State highway department. It was mentioned that the Director of the State Highway Patrol had ordered the Officers to start patrolling the country roads more. Councilman McDonald, said he would see Mr. Eugene Holmes about trying to get Mr. Nelson to put up the street signs and do more work on roads in town limits.

There was a discussion on privilege License collection. The firms doing business in the town were very slow about paying the license fees. A motion was made by Councilman Patton, that the town pay an individual 10.00 to make a house to house survey, to find out what insurance companies were doing business in the town. Councilman McDonald seconded the Motion. All members present voted in favor of the motion. Mrs. Ruth Livingston was to be contacted about doing the survey.

There being no further business to come before the Council, The same was, on motion, duly adjourned.
