

THE MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF EVA,
ALABAMA, HELD ON JANUARY 13, 1966.

The Council of the Town of Eva, Alabama held their regular meeting on January 13, 1966, at the School in the Town of Eva, at 7:00 P.M.
