

REGULAR MEETING OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF EVA,
ALABAMA, JANUARY 14, 1971

The meeting of the town and council of the town of Eva, Alabama met in the town of Eva at Claude Patton's Service Station. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Ryan. A roll call was had and all the councilmen were found present.

There was a general discussion of the progress of the City Hall. A regular move and second by Councilman Livingston and Patton to pay bills of \$514.98 to Hartselle Building Supply, \$131.75 to Walker Bros. Building Supply, and \$162.25 to be allowed paid. The move carried and the bills were ordered paid. Also, a bill of \$2.25 to Councilman Livingston for recording a erected deed to the city property was voted and allowed paid.

A move and second was made and carried, to buy a rummage pile of brick for use on the City Hall building. W. E. Smith was authorized to make the purchase.
