

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF
EVA, ALABAMA, HELD ON JUNE 11, 1964.

The Mayor and Council of the Town of Eva, Alabama, held their regular meeting on June 11, 1964, at the school in the Town of Eva, Alabama, at 7:00 P.M.

The Mayor called the meeting to order and ask the Town Clerk to call the roll. All members of the Town's governing body, consisting of the Mayor and five Councilmen, were present for this meeting. The Mayor then ask the Town Clerk to read the minutes of the previous meeting. There were no corrections to be made in the minutes so the Mayor declared the minutes approved as read.

The Mayor then ask for reports from any committees. There were no committees present to give any reports.

The Mayor then ask for other information that should be brought before the Council relating to resolutions, ordinances, orders, and other business. There were no ordinances presented for consideration at this meeting. The privilege license code was discussed regarding ways of collecting the money for privilege licenses that were passed due. A motion was made by Councilman McDonald for the Mayor to get in touch with Mr. Albert Brewer, City Attorney, to see when he could meet with the Town's governing body for the purpose of discussing various problems of the Town. This motion was seconded by Councilman Patton. All members voted in favor of this motion. The Mayor read a letter from Mr. Albert Brewer regarding his fee for services rendered to the town. A motion was made by Councilman McDonald that the matter be tabled until after a meeting with Mr. Brewer. This motion was seconded by Councilman Patton. All members voted in favor of this motion.

The Town Clerk presented his resignation effective July 9, 1964. The Mayor appointed Councilman Patton and Councilman Livingston to contact someone to fill the vacancy.

A motion was made by Councilman McDonald to purchase a map of the Corporate limits of the Town of Eva, Alabama. This motion was seconded by

Councilman Patton. All members voted in favor of this motion.

There being no further business to come before the Council,
the same was, on motion, duly ajourned.
