

REGULAR MEETING OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF EVA, ALABAMA
JULY 10, 1969

The mayor and council of the town of Eva, Alabama held their regular meeting in the town of Eva, Alabama on July 10, 1969 at 7:00 p.m.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Ryan. The roll call was had and all the councilmen were present.

Councilman R. L. Livingston was appointed at a previous meeting to make necessary investigations to purchase insurance for the city's fire truck. At this time, he made a report that State Farm gave the best price of \$48.00 for six months with uninsured motorist of \$52.40 for a six month period. Councilman Patton made a motion that was seconded by Councilman Hipps to take out insurance at \$52.40 per six months. The move carried.

The subject was brought up and discussed about city paying the \$50.00 deductible portion of John Smith's truck insurance. It was agreed of probable conflict with probable conflict with insurance claim against city if Smith's insurance company could prove we admitted fault by paying Mr. Smith's \$50.00. It was also discussed that Mr. Smith was a good voluntary fire fighter and always willing to help with the fire truck. It was ascertained that Mr. Smith was not able to stand the loss at the present time. A motion was made to table subject until the next meeting, and a committee of two was appointed to investigate subject further.

The mayor appointed Councilman R. L. Livingston and Mitchell Hipps.

The meeting was adjourned after a move and second.
