

MINUTES OF THE CALLED MEETING OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF EVA, ALABAMA, HELD ON JUNE 20, 1966.

The Mayor and the Council of the Town of Eva, Alabama, held a called meeting on June 20, 1966, at the school in the Town of Eva, Alabama, at 7:30 B.M.

The Mayor called the meeting to order and the roll of members was called. All members of the town's governing body, consisting of the Mayor and five Councilmen, were present at the meeting. The reading of the minutes of the previous meeting was dispensed with.

The Council and Mayor then heard a report from Mr. Joe Worley. Mr. Worley spoke to the meeting in regard to a city water system. He explained the steps necessary in order to obtain loans and grants. Other interested parties along the Eva-Cullman Road were also present at the meeting. It was moved by Councilman Patton that the city hire Joe Worley & Associates to do the preliminary survey. This motion was seconded by Councilman McDonald. All members voted in favor of this motion.

A discussion was then held by the Council and Mayor as in regard to the hiring of a lawyer. By an unanimous decision of the council, it was decided that the city would contact several different law firms in regard to hiring a lawyer. The suggestion was made that the city hire someone who had experience in obtaining water systems.

There being no further business to come before the council, the same was, on the motion, duly adjourned.
