After lengthy discussion on the topic of the city's property and prospective City Hall building, R. L. Livingston was appointed by Mayor Ryan to contact Commissioner Nelson and find out possibility of getting culverts and fill dirt for the property. It was also decided that further plans on the building be delayed until these projects were finished.

The meeting was adjourned by a regular move and second.
