

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF
EVA, ALABAMA, HELD ON MARCH 12, 1964.

The Mayor and Council of the Town of Eva, Alabama, held their regular meeting on March 12, 1964, at the school in the Town of Eva, Alabama, at 7:00 P.M.

The Mayor called the meeting to order and ask the Town Clerk to call the roll. Councilman L. E. Oden was the only member of the Town's governing body, consisting of a Mayor and five Councilmen, that was not present for this meeting. The Mayor then ask the Town Clerk to read the minutes of the previous meeting. After the reading of the minutes, the Mayor ask if there were any corrections to be made in the minutes. There were no corrections to be made so the Mayor declared the minutes approved as read.

The Mayor then ask for reports of any committees. There were no committees present to give any reports.

The Mayor then ask for other information that should be brought before the Council relating to resolutions, ordinances, orders, and other business. There were no ordinances presented for consideration at this meeting. The Town Clerk was ask to give a report on the privilege license. The report showed that forty-eight privilege licenses had been issued. The Mayor and Council then spent some time looking over the list of people who had been notified of the privilege license ordinance. The Mayor then read a letter from Mr. Albert Brewer, City Attorney, clarifying some of the difficulties that we were having with the privilege license. Next, the Mayor brought up the recent visit of the officials of Joe Wheeler Electric Coop. and ask the Council how did they think Joe Wheeler Coop. should base the gross receipts in purchasing their privilege license for 1964. A motion was made by Councilman Patton that Joe Wheeler Electric Coop. pay for their 1964 license on the gross receipts of 1963. This motion was seconded by Councilman McDonald. After the discussion, all

members of the governing body present voted in favor of this motion.

The Town Clerk was instructed to send the following letter to the Joe Wheeler Electric Coop.:

The Town Clerk was also instructed to send a letter to Mr. Albert Brewer, City Attorney, requesting additional information on privilege license regarding people who come into town to do plumbing work or repair electrical appliances. The Town Clerk presented to the Council two bills for consideration. One for \$4.30 owed to Office Equipment Co. for book binder for minutes of the meetings of the Town Council, another one for \$24.50 owed to Decatur Printing Co. for printing 500 sets of privilege licenses. A motion was made by Councilman McDonald instructing Town Clerk to pay the two bills mentioned above. This motion was seconded by Councilman Patton. All members present voted in favor of this motion.

There being no further business to come before the Council, the same was, on motion, duly ajourned.
