

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF
EVA, ALABAMA, HELD ON MARCH 11, 1965.

Mayor and Council held a regular meeting, March 11, 1965, at ~~the~~
the School, in the town of Eva, Alabama. 7:00 PM.

The Mayor called the meeting to order and ask the clerk to call the roll. All members of the Council were present. The Mayor then ask that the minutes of the previous meeting be read. No corrections were needed, the minutes were approved as read.

The Mayor ask for reports from any committees.
Councilman Oden of the Finance committee reported that the town bank account was \$1038.06. The Mayor stated that he had received a letter from the Morgan County board of revenue, inviting him to attend a meeting, to be held in Decatur, on the Economic Opportunity Act. That he intended to be present at the meeting.

Councilman McDonald of Street, Parks and Cemetery Committee reported that the Town limits and stop signs had been installed. There was a discussion on what the town could do toward the upkeep of the cemetery. It was decided that a donation from the town would probably be the best thing to do.

Councilman Livingston of Sanitation and recreation reported that some discussion had gone on about a play ground, had been proposed on the grounds of the Methodist Church, to be used by all the children of the town. A discussion was held on the possibilities of the town helping toward that.

Councilman Patton of Utilities reported that he had talked with an individual from Garden City, Alabama, concerning the water system there. Garden City, uses a well to furnish all the water that they need at the present time. There was a discussion on trying to get a meeting arranged with Mr. Causey, the geologist stationed in Cullman, to get his opinion on the possibilities of getting a well to furnish enough water for the Town.

Councilman Hipps of Police and Fire Departments Committee reported that one of the town limits signs and some of the school bus stop signs had been removed by vandals. The Mayor reported that vandals had done other damage around town. Sherriff Fleming had promised his services toward the arrest of the guilty ones. Mayor Ryan said he would try to talk with Sherriff Fleming, when he was in Decatur to attend the meeting with the Board of Revenue.

The Mayor ask for any other information that should be brought before the Council, relating to resolutions, ordinances, orders and other business. There were no ordinances presented for consideration at this meeting. Councilman Patton made a motion that the town inquire about the possibility of acquiring a surplus fire truck. The motion was second by Councilman McDonald. All Members of the Council voted in favor.

There being no further business to come before the Council, the same was, on motion, duly adjourned.
