

MINUTES OF A CALLED MEETING OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF EVA,  
ALABAMA, HELD ON MARCH 17, 1967

The Mayor and Council of the Town of Eva, Alabama, held a called meeting on March 17, 1967.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Ryan, and a roll call was taken. This special session was held for the purpose of discussing the the buying of a parcel of land from J. E. Woodard. This land is lying in the East part of the City, bound on the West side by Alabama Highway No. 55, on the North by a dirt road known as the Billy Goat Hollow Road.

After the discussion, Councilman L. E. Oden made a motion that the City purchase the land at a price of \$1200. Councilman Patton seconded the motion and the Clerk was voted the authority to make payment by check.

Mayor Ryan reported that the Water Committee was to hold a meeting Monday night, March 20, 1967. A short report was given for the cause of the hold up on the progress of the water system.

A move and second was received to adjourn until our next regular meeting.
