

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF EVA,
ALABAMA. HELD ON MARCH 14, 1968 IN THE SCHOOL BUILDING IN THE TOWN OF EVA,
ALABAMA.

The Mayor called the meeting to order. The roll was called and all the councilmen were present except councilman L. E. Oden. The minutes of the last communication were read and approved.

The council met with the Principal and Trustees and of the town and surrounding area for the purpose of hearing a report from the school principal, Guinn Mason, on receiving aid from the United Givers Fund for organizing a community recreation program. The Little League and larger base ball teams were discussed for joining a county wide league. A general discussion was had and agreement reached to return the following Thursday night, March 21, 1968.

Mayor Ryan made a report on the organizing of a volunteer fire fighter group. He also gave information concerning reduced insurance rates as a result of this fire fighting group. Also the possibility of using the telephone as a means of alarm system. A list of names was received of men who would be willing to serve. A selection will be derived from these for the team.

There was a move by councilman R. L. Livingston and a second by councilman Hipps that a bill of \$3.28 for taxes on the city, be allowed paid. The move carried.

A report of fire calls was made of the following people; Mrs. L. E. Bates, G. C. Minor, V. D. Holloway, and Ora Holmes. The council voted to send out statements for payments.
