

THE MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF
EVA, ALABAMA , HELD ON MARCH 20, 1969.

The mayor called the meeting to order and had the roll called. All the governing body was found present. The minutes of the last regular communication were read and approved.

Councilman McDonald gave a short report on some research he made pertaining to plans and prices for a city hall building. A general discussion was had on proposed plans for a building and it was agreed to pursue plans for a building. Tentative plans are for a 40 x 60 ft. steel building with 2 12 x 12 ft. metal overhead doors, gutters and downspouts, brick and glass front, 1 in. vinyl faced fiberglass insulation under all metal surfaces and factory enamel color. Re-enforced 4in. concrete slab with vapor barrier in all office area and 5 in. re-enforced with vapor barrier concrete slab in warehouse areas. Office area to be 20 x 40 ft. with pre-finished panneling on walls, accustical ceiling and vinyl asbestos floor tyle. No price for plumbing, heating, or electrical work was included in the price. The total estimated price was \$10,984.00. This is entered for record only.

After al general discussion of general business, the meeting was adjourned by a move and second.
