

THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE TOWN AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF EVA, EVA,
ALABAMA, MARCH 11, 1971

The mayor and council of the town of Eva, Alabama, met on March 11, 1971, at Patton's Service Station in the town of Eva, Alabama at 7:30 p.m.

The main topic of agenda was a generalized discussion of the construction and material for the City Hall building. Plans for continuation of the construction were made. It was agreed that J. J. Childers would oversee the carpentry work. There has been free labor offered and agreed to be accepted and hire the necessary remaining work.
