The Regular meeting of the town council of the Town of Eva, Alabama,

The Regular meeting of the town council of the city of Eva, Alabama met in the City Hall in the Town of Eva, Alabama on the 2nd day of March 1973. Mayor Ryan ordered and received a roll call of the Councilmen. All were present. The minutes of all previous unapproved meetings were read and approved.

The Clerk presented the note their annual note from the State National Bank of Falkville on the City Hall. Councilman Livingston made a motion that the city pay \$1,000 on the principal plus interest at the rate of 6.5% per annum. Councilman Patton made a second and the motion carried. A bill from State Farm Insurance Company of 58.20 for premium on The Grass Fire truck also 34.60 paid by Arthur Price, agent who paid partial payment. Councilman Smith made a motion that the bills be allowed paid. Councilman McDonald seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Mayor Ryan read a Communication from George C. Wallace requesting a Contribution on research and development of "Ameraport Research Funds Campaign." After a short discussion, it was tabled for future reference.

The mayor read to the Council, Communication from the Internal Revenue of the U. S. A. on rules of receiving and expending of funds received under the Revenue Sharing Program. The various forms received to date were filled out and given to the clerk for mailing.

There was a short discussion on the unpaid privilege license from companies who operat in the city. It was suggested that all known companies who have not paid, be contacted and requested to do so.
