

March 1974

The Town council of the town of Eva met at the town hall on their regular meeting on the 14th day of March 1974.

Mayor Ryan called for and received the reading of the minutes of the last communications. The minutes were read and approved.

Mayor Ryan made a generalized report on the water system and the possibility of obtaining water hydrants in the city of Eva. Each plug will cost approximately \$325.00 each. It was discussed the possibility of obtaining five hydrants for the city. A previously appointed committee of councilman Patton, Chairman, Councilman McDonald and Councilman Hipps will be responsible for further investigation of this matter.

Mayor Ryan brought several matters of general business before the council. Of these the city cemetery was discussed and it was mentioned that we take an action interest in the up hap and maintainance of said subject.

Councilman Patton made a motion and received a second by Councilman Livingston that the city pay their contract application for water system for the city hall building. The motion carried and the bill was allowed paid of \$15.00 dues.

A discussion on the unpaid city license from companies who deliver in the city and who have not purchased a city delivery license. This was tabled until our next meeting.
