The Regular meeting of the Town and Council of the Town of Eva Alabama, met in the City hall in the city of Eva, Ala.

Mayor Ryan asked for and received a motion and second to dispense with the reading of the minutes of the last communication. The motion carried.

A report of the financial standing of the three bank accounts was received with the following: General fund \$667.24; Gasoline fund \$450.83 and Revenue sharing \$926.05.

A renewed call for old business found still no report on the old outstanding privilege license. Mayor Ryan tabled the report until the next meeting.

A Bill from State Farm Insurance for City Hall insurance premium of \$84.00 received a motion and second and was voted and allowed paid. A bill for \$50.00 for North Alabama Mayors Association was presented and motioned to be tabled for future reference.

Mayor Ryan reported that the ledgers of the three accounts were up-to-date and that he carried a recap of each account to the F.N.D. office to apply for a loan for to install fire hydrants in the City. The money can be had upon receipt of and an appraisal from a licensed bonding Company on the City. This report will cost approximately \$200.00. The Council agree to table this portion of the loan procedure for the time being.

Mayor Ryan reported that Farm Bureau Insurance Co. pledged \$40.00 toward the fire plug, also the Woodman of the World Insurance donated \$100.00 worth of equipment to the fire Dept. Mayor Ryan asked for a volunteer

to go before the County Board of Education and ask for a donation toward the City fire plugs.
Councilman McDonald and Mayor Ryan agreed to go meet the board.

A discussion on the progress of the Volunteer fire Dept. brought to light a problem of the Dept. making very little progress. It was mentioned to bring the Department back under the jurisdiction of the Town Council. No final decision was made.

On a motion and second the meeting was adjourned until the next regular meeting.
