

REGULAR MEETING OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF EVA, ALABAMA
MAY 13, 1971

The regular meeting of the mayor and council of the town of Eva, Alabama met in the city of Eva, Alabama at 7:00 p.m. on the 13th day of May, 1971.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Ryan. The roll call was had, and all councilmen were present except Councilman McDonald who was away on business.

There was a generalized discussion on the lighting of the city of Eva. It was agreed by move and second and a unanimous vote in favor, to engage Joe Wheeler Co-operative to improve lights around the new City Hall building together with additional street lights. Councilman Hipps made the motion and received a second by Councilman Patton.

The following bills were presented to the body for approval for payment:

85.05	Mayor Ryan to be paid to C. A. Morgan for fire equipment to go on fire truck.

Councilman R. L. Livingston made a move and seconded by Councilman Hipps that the bills be paid. The move carried and the bills were ordered and allowed paid.

After the general business of the meeting was taken care of, Councilman L. E. Oden made a short and impressive talk, at the conclusion of which he presented his resignation from the council. A copy of which is attached with these minutes. All the councilmen present each made a short acceptance talk, after which Councilman Patton made a motion and Councilman R. L. Livingston seconded to accept Councilman L. E. Oden's resignation. The motion was unanimously carried and councilman Oden's services were officially released.

The meeting was adjourned by a regular move and second.
