

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF
EVA, ALABAMA, HELD ON NOVEMBER 12, 1964.

The Mayor and Council of the town of Eva, Alabama held their regular meeting on November 12, 1964, at the school in the town of Eva, Alabama at 7:00 P.M.

The Mayor called the meeting to order and ask the town clerk to call the roll. All members of the towns governing body, consisting of the Mayor and five Councilmen, were present, except Councilman L.E. Oden. The Mayor ask the town clerk to read the minutes of the last meeting held, this minutes being that of the meeting held on August 13, 1964, as no meeting was held on September 10, 1964 or October 8, 1964. A quorum was not present on either of these dates. Councilman McDonald, Councilman Hipps and the town clerk were present on September 10, 1964 and Councilman McDonald, Councilman Patton and the town clerk were present on October 8, 1964. No one was present with any business for the Councils consideration at either of these dates. There being no corrections of the minutes, the Mayor declared the minutes approved as read.

The Mayor then ask for reports from any committees. Councilman McDonald, Chairman of the Streets, Parks and Cemetery committee, reported that he had contacted Mr. Nelson, who assured him that the signs would be installed on the streets. Mr. Nelson said that Lizzie Lane should be graded up one year and then paved the next. There was a discussion on possibilities of the town bearing part of the expense of the maintenance of the cemetery.

The Mayor then ask for other information that should be brought before the Council, relating to resolutions, ordinances, orders and other business. There were no ordinances or resolutions presented for consideration at this meeting. There was a discussion on funds the town should be getting from the state. A decision was made that Councilman Oden, Chairman of the Finance committee should contact Probate Judge Alman, for any information he could give concerning this matter of the funds.

The Mayor presented a bill from V.H. Padgett for \$4.00, to be paid for 6 B-W. prints of the town. A motion was made by councilman Livingston, that the clerk be authorized to pay this bill to Mr. Padgett (\$4.00) The motion was seconded by Councilman Patton. All members present voted in favor of this Motion.

There being no further business to come before the Council, the same was, on motion, duly ajourned.
