THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF EVA, ALABAMA WAS HELD IN THE TOWN HALL ON NOVEMBER 14, 1974 AT 7:30 PM

THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER AND ROLL CALLED ALL MEMBERS PRESENT.

THE MINUTES OF THE SEPT. MEETING WAS READ AND ACCEPTED., NO MEETING WAS HELD IN OCTOBER. MAYOR AND TWO COUNCIL MEMBERS WERE OUT OF TOWN ON REGULAR MEETING DATE.

THE MAYOR REPORTED THAT MR. BROWN OF FHA WOULD NOT LET THE TOWN FILE FOR A GRANT WITH THAT AGENCY. MR. WORLEY IS TRYING TO OBTAIN AN APPLICATION FOR THE TOWN TO USE TO APPLY FOR

THE COST OF THE FIRE HYDRANTS. THE HYDRANTS SHOULD BE SPACED ABOUT 500 FT. IN DOWN TOWN AREA AND 800 FT. IN OUT LYING AREA. THE COST WOULD BE ABOUT \$5500.00 .

CLAUD PATTON MADE A MOTION THAT THE TOWN APPLY FOR A GRANT FROM FHA FOR THE COST OF THE HYDRANTS. THE MOTION WAS SECONDED BY TERRELL LIVINGSTON . THE MOTION WAS PASSED BY THE COUNCIL.

MOTION MADE BY MITCHELL HIPPS, TO SET UP MEETING WITH CULLMAN COUNTY COMMISSION TO DISCUSS COST OF HYDRANTS AFTER INSTALLATION SECONDED BY JOHN SMITH. PASSED BY COUNCIL.

MOTION MADE BY L.G. MCDONALD TO CONTACT CENTRAL BANK OF ALABAMA FALKVILLE BRANCH TO OBTAIN SHORT TERM LOAN TO FINANCE HYDRANTS UNTILL OTHER FUNDS CAN BE OBTAINED. SECONDED BY MITCHELL HIPPS PASSED BY COUNCIL

JOHN SMITH MADE MOTION TO PAY CULLMAN TRIBUNE \$9.38 BILL CHARGED FOR PUBLICATION OF REVENUE SHARING REPORT. SECONDED BY TERRELL LIVINGSTON PASSED BY COUNCIL

CLAUD PATTON MADE MOTION TO DECLINE PAYMENT OF DUES TO LEAGUE OF MUNICIPALITIES, DUE TO DEPLETION OF FUNDS IN TOWN TREASURY. SECONDED BY L.G. MCDONALD PASSED BY COUNCIL

MAYOR REPORTED THAT THE ROAD ON WEST SIDE HAD BEEN GRADED UP AND GRAVELED WITH PROMISE TO PAVE NEXT YEAR.
