

Minutes of the meeting of the Mayor and Council of the Town of Eva held in a special call at 7 p.m. on October 19, 1978, present: Roland Ryan, Mayor, and the following members of the Council: Jerry Mobley, Terrell Livingston, Jimmy Mosteller and Alton Page.

Minutes of the October 12, 1978 meeting were read and approved. Financial report was given as follows:

General Fund - \$1359.15 with \$320.22 in transitory funds	(1679.37)
Gasoline Tax Fund - \$49.18	
Revenue Sharing - \$497.76 with \$192.00 in transitory	(689.76)
Volunteer Fire Department - \$403.78	

The Clerk reported an error in her figures of the September 21 meeting. She asked for approval to correct the \$27.24 addition error in the Gasoline Tax Fund. Mr. Page offered the motion to correct said error. Motion was seconded by Mr. Livingston.

Mr. Page reported on his participation in the Physician's Opportunity Fair on Oct. 14. He had several inquiries, saying that most seemed to be interested in locating in a small town rather than in a large, competitive city. If the Council desires to talk to classes at UAB, this can be arranged through UAB's Placement Office. The Mayor, in behalf of the Council, expressed appreciation to Councilman Page for his efforts, and the apparent good job he did at the Physician's Opportunity Fair.

The Mayor stated that the Central Bank of Falkville has committed to lend the Town of Eva the \$11,037 to pay for installation of the Town's fire hydrants. Although Councilman Morgan is still hospitalized and has not yet signed the resolution, the Council agreed to go ahead with processing the loan since he, in earlier meetings, had always voted in the affirmative on this project. Mr. Mobley offered the motion that we proceed with the loan, and that it be paid monthly over a seven-year period. This was seconded by Mr. Page.

Mr. Mobley gave a brief report on the recent survey on extending the City Limits. All participating in the survey ran into the problem of people not being at home on the particular Saturday the survey was conducted. Councilmen Mobley and Livingston will try to see some of the people that have not yet been contacted at night when perhaps they will be home.

There being no further business, Mr. Page offered the motion that the meeting be adjourned; seconded by Mr. Mosteller.
