

Minutes of the meeting of the Town Council of Eva held in regular session at 7 p.m. on October 11, 1979, attended by the Mayor and Councilmen Mobley, Livingston, Page and Morgan.

Minutes of the September 13 meeting were read and approved. A financial report, giving end of September totals, was presented as follows:

General Fund	\$ 479.55 (+ \$1500 in passbook savings)
Gasoline Tax Fund	205.40
Revenue Sharing	\$1172.76 (+ transitory check of \$164)
Volunteer Fire Dept.	827.69

The Mayor reported that the Alarm System was ordered, but that it hasn't come in yet. He led a discussion about the water problem at the Senior Citizens Center. Mr. Livingston reported that Mr. Childers had worked on the pump and had installed a separate switch box. He had said that he would put a porch onto the building and a concrete slab at the entrance. Before anything further is done about the water business, it was decided to wait and see how this new arrangement works. Mr. Morgan offered the motion to delay the installation of the water meter until we see how the other arrangement works; motion seconded by Mr. Page carried.

The Mayor then reported on his participation at the Physician's Opportunity Fair in Birmingham. He said that it was very interesting, and he got some insight on what is going on over the state. He learned that there are about 55 Family Practice doctors becoming available each year, but that the attrition rate is more than that number. Family practice was the highest priority on the agenda. The Mayor said that we need to begin work on this right away, and first thing would be to contact Dr. Sarrell, Anniston Medical Clinic.

The Mayor presented the contract for the Eva Nutrition Site that has been renewed. After discussion, Mr. Mobley offered the motion that we renew the contract. It was seconded by Mr. Page and motion carried.

Among the pieces of mail discussed was a letter from Erwin T. Koch of St. Louis who wanted to be named an honorary citizen and good will ambassador of the Town of Eva. Mr. Morgan offered the motion, seconded by Mr. Page that we make Mr. Koch an honorary citizen. The Mayor suggested we send him a copy of the writeup on the Town of Eva.

The Mayor quoted from the report of the elderly survey for September. A narrative report will be completed and submitted to NARCOG. It was the consensus that this special project has been worthwhile.

The Mayor asked the Clerk to check with Mrs. Gilleen in the Water Dept. to ask about the taxes that the Town of Eva is being charged on the water bill.

Bills presented for payment were Office Equipment Co. \$17.81; Water bill \$6.76; Phone bill \$34.05; Clerk's Salary \$111.04; 6 months insurance on white truck \$59.00. Mr. Mbley offered the motion that we pay the bills; seconded by Mr. Page.

There being no further business, Mr. Page offered the motion that the meeting be adjourned.
