

September 13, 1973

The Town Council of the Town of Eva, Alabama met in regular communication in their hall on the 13th day of Sept. 1973 at 7:30 p.m.

Mayor Ryan called the meeting to order and ordered the minutes of the last regular and all other unapproved minutes read. They were read and accordingly approved.

The first order of business was the final discussion and election of a councilman to fill the unexpired term of councilman R. L. Livingston, who passed away Aug. 14, 1973. There was a regular move by councilman Claude Patton and seconded by councilman John Smith that Terrell Livingston be elected for the unexpired term. A vote was taken and he was unanimously elected.

Bills for Flowers to Ann's Flourist for passed councilman R. L. Livingston's flowers in the amount of \$15.90 and to the Cullman Times for \$8.22 for advertisement on use of our revenue sharing. The bills were ordered and allowed paid.

Mayor Ryan made a report on the proposed water system. He reported on a discussion he had with Dick Flemming, regarded the proposed system.

The forms the proposed expenditures of our revenue sharing dividends were filled out to be returned to the proper destination. It was decided that \$110.00 would be spent for office equipment and \$178.00 for repair on fire truck. This constitutes our entitlement period beginning July 1, 1973 thru June 30, 1974.
