

Minutes of the regular meeting of the Mayor and Council of the Town of Eva.

The Mayor and Councilmen Jerry Mobley and Jimmy Mosteller met at a regular meeting on September 14, 1978, at 7 p.m.

Since there was not a quorum, regular business was dispensed with. A financial report was given as follows:

General fund	\$1905.99
Revenue Sharing Fund	497.76
Gas Tax Fund	36.25
Volunteer Fire Dept.	235.53

Bills presented for payment were the following: Coy Frost for rocking parking lot--\$125.00; for septic tank and field lines--\$450.00; Office Equipment Company for set of keys for file cabinet--\$4.00. Jerry Mobley made the motion that said bills be paid; seconded by Jimmy Mosteller.

Pam Pigg, Coordinator for the Morgan County Aging Program presented some information to the City Council on establishing a Senior Services Center at Eva. She said the first step would be to find 150 people over age 60 who would participate; and get the names and addresses to her before October 1. Find a building to accommodate up to 30 persons a day. The building would have to pass certain Health Dept. requirements. When the information is given to NARCOG, the Nutrition Project Director out of NARCOG will get the site started. The County Commission will get a van through NARCOG. You have to contract with the city or the county to pay the van driver, and service the van. The county furnishes insurance, and can probably get the van serviced at the county barn. Her office will work out such details later. She said at other Sites the van driver is paid for 7 hours a day; the site manager is paid for 4 hours a day (10 to 2); and aids are paid also. Ms. Pigg said that since she couldn't answer all our questions, being new on this job, she would like to arrange for us to get more information from the NARCOG office in Decatur. NARCOG funds the program. The Mayor asked that Bonnie Holmes work with Ms. Pigg on the program, get what facts she could together, get the senior citizens survey done, so that we can get our request for a Site in before October 1.

The Mayor said that there would be a Call Meeting of the City Council for next Thursday night since so many of the Councilmen were not able to attend the regular meeting.
