

Minutes of the meeting of the Town Council of Eva held in regular session at 7 p.m. on September 13, 1979, attended by the Mayor, and all 5 members of the Council. However, Mr. Morgan joined the meeting late.

Minutes of the August 9 meeting were read and approved. A financial report, giving end of August totals, was presented as follows:

General Fund	\$ 648.06 (+ \$1500 in passbook savings)
Gasoline Tax Fund	\$ 188.55
Revenue Sharing	\$1172.76
Volunteer Fire Department	\$ 827.69

The Mayor reported on the meeting of the Vol. Fire Dept. held September 10. He said that the Fire Dept. funds have to be committed before the end of September and that at the Fire Dept meeting they had voted to buy the alarm system/siren for the building. He said also that they agreed to transfer the old white truck to Gum Pond. After discussion, Mr. Mobley offered the motion that we buy and install the alarm system on top of City Hall. Motion, seconded by Mr. Page, carried. Mr. Mosteller then offered the motion that we spend the Revenue Sharing Funds to pay on this alarm system for the Vol. Fire Dept. Motion seconded by Mr. Mobley, carried.

The Mayor then read from the report of the August Elderly Survey, showing a total of 144 surveyed, of whom 66 were over age 70. Four with special needs were reported to the County Aging Office. This month's survey took place in the Priceville/Somerville area where the County Aging Office is trying to establish another Site. The Mayor stated that the last week of the contract, the survey workers will do follow-up work in the Eva Area.

A discussion followed about the water problem at the Senior Citizens Center. Terrell Livingston was asked to contact Mr. Childers about installing a water meter if the Site participants would pay for the water line and get it put in. Mr. Page offered the motion that if Mr. Childers would not install the meter, that the Town of Eva have it done and that if and when the building were no longer used for a Center that the Town move it to another location where it might be needed. Motion was seconded by Mr. Mosteller, and motion carried.

The Physicians Opportunity Fair to be held in Birmingham on September 29 was discussed. At this time no one could promise to be available to go, so this will be decided later. It was decided to draft a summary sheet about Eva to be handed out at the Fair, and to have a registration pad available to keep a record of those who visit Eva's booth.

Mr. Page offered the motion, seconded by Mr. Mobley, that we pay the Town of Eva bills as follows: Morgan Co. Concrete \$113.25 and Coy Frost for rock and finishing sidewalk \$65.00; Jack Hopper for supplies (Paint rollers, etc.) \$8.47; Corrected phone bill \$40.49 of which \$8.75 was paid by Senior Citizens; Water Bill \$5.72; Mr. Millwood for mowing \$70; Postage stamps \$15; Clerk's salary for August \$111.04.

The Mayor led a discussion about the school situation, saying that he had volunteered Town Hall for a meeting which was attended by 44 people (at least this number registered), and it was agreed on to meet again tomorrow night following the County Board Meeting tonight. Results of a survey indicated that there are over 70 children who live over two road miles from school who are not being picked up by bus.

There being no further business, Mr. Mobley offered the motion that the meeting be adjourned, seconded by Mr. Page.
