

Minutes of Meeting of Eva Town Council held in regular session on April 8, 1982, at 7 p.m., attended by Mayor Ryan and all five Councilmen. Minutes of the March 12 meeting were read and approved. Financial report was accepted as presented, giving end-of-March balances as follows:

Old Business:

- (1) Evidently banks can branch across county lines. That being the case, all banks in the area will be contacted for interest in locating a branch in Eva. The Mayor read a draft for the proposed letter, with a listing of names of persons to contact. Clerk will send out the letters as soon as possible.
- (2) Doctor: Only thing left is finding a facility. The doctors involved seem to like the idea of a trailer which would be more serviceable. Attorney Sherman Powell recommended a written agreement including time, control of facilities, liability, etc. The Mayor will call Ronald Sparkman at Hartselle Medical Center, then call Attorney Powell to draft the proposed agreement.
- (3) Door at Senior Citizens Center: Birlen Childers said we could re-open one of the doors in the bathrooms, according to Councilman Hipps. Hipps will take care of getting this done.
- (4) Business pertaining to car for Law Enforcement was tabled until a later date.
- (5) Gasoline Leak: Attorney will write a letter to the Gulf, Texaco and Exxon distributors advising them of the Town's Ordinance, and requesting that each distributor and retailer be aware that the Council intends to inspect equipment, contents, invoices, records, etc. and that they should be prepared to furnish said information to Town Council to reconcile information. Clerk will furnish Powell with names and addresses of distributors.  
Clerk will prepare letter to owner of the tanks at Eva 66 station that have been abandoned, asking owner to take action as prescribed in Exhibit B of Ordinance 81-1.
- (6) Enos Frank was contacted about the building on the corner; asked \$11,500 for it. No decision by Council on further contact.
- (7) Paving of Town Hall Parking Lot and Area in front of Eva 4-Way: Clerk will contact bidders and ask for new bids or verification of old bids on Parking Lot, and for a separate bid (different account) to repair area in front of Eva 4-Way. This motion made by Hipps was seconded, and carried.

New Business:

- (1) Attorney Sherman Powell who was present at the meeting agreed to continue serving as Attorney for Town of Eva.
- (2) Motion offered by Livingston, seconded by Hipps, carried, for Howard Millwood to mow the grass around Eva Town Hall area @ \$12.50.
- (3) Bills authorized for payment were the following:  
From General Fund- Water bill \$6.76; Electric bill \$20.97; Triple A for termite proofing \$300.00; Postage stamps \$20.00; Petrolane Gas for Senior Citizens \$93.47; Net phone bill \$36.01; Appropriation for Mental Health \$58.00; Clerk's salary for March \$110.22 (\$100.22 salary plus \$10 travel).  
From Volunteer Fire Dept. Fund-Ray Cheatham's 2d quarter tuition at WSCC for EMT-2 course \$96.00; 6-mos. premium on 1964 white truck \$53.60; Cal Gas for VFD Bldg. \$129.01; Jack Hopper Groc. for paint \$23.22.  
From Gasoline Tax Fund- Street Lights \$122.98. Motion offered by Hipps, seconded by Mobley, carried, to transfer \$100 from general fund to gasoline tax fund to cover this.  
Motion made by Hipps, seconded by Mobley, carried, that meeting be adjourned.
