

Agenda - Eva Town Council Meeting April 14, 1988

Old Business:

- 1-Hydrants are being installed; need to order 1 more standard hydrant at Kenneth Widner's house near county line.
- 2-No word from Bob Woodruff about status of the signs.
- 3-Any word from Mr. Jones on landscaping project? Did Mayor talk *play ground East*
- 4-Any agreement with Hartselle Medical Center/NHL?
- 5-Did Mayor talk with Don Hale to see if he ever talked to the man in Birmingham about the mail routes?
- 6-Curb at the Post Office entrance.
- 7-Fire Hall addition?
- 8-Did Mayor talk to Mr. Chaffin about improving looks of the building, and around it?
- 9-Letter was sent to Joe Wheeler about the street light at Fisherman's Catch, and the one on Lindler Street near Bobby Smith's.
- 10-Coy Frost fix entrance to restaurant?
- 11-Did Gafton come out about where the grader knocked a hole in the culvert on Chris' Road?
- 12-Letter was sent to County about the Sheriff's car. Bid was given to Eddie Preuitt Ford for his low bid of \$12,748.

- 14-Clerk called Attorney at Alabama League, and was told that it would be in violation of #94 if we made any special arrangements other than what the adopted policies say, for the Morgan County Gospel Music Association. Also, he said that we could not donate the money back to them. He said if they want to use the building, they must pay the \$50 according to the established policy. Mayor sent a letter to Mr. Ford informing him of this decision by League Attorney, according to Alabama law.
