New Business

- 1-Mr. John Symonds of Pro-Stripe in Cullman, said that if and when Council decides to lay out and stripe the parking lots at Library or new Fire Hall, they would like to bid on it. He said they did the striping of the parking lot at Jack's Foodland (layout, too).
- 2-Move office/conference room to New Fire Hall?
- 3-Request from A.P. & Vonda Holmes, Richard & Haskell Davis and Posey White to be annexed into city limits. I told them about problems involved with some property owners in between not wanting in the city limits. They will talk to some property owners from Fowler's side, going west down O.Z. Davis Road, and will get back with council if they get good response.
- 4-VFD Chief requests authorization to order a new book, "Fire Department Pumping Apparatus" at a cost of \$20; also Eva Fire Dept. and EMT patches totaling \$136.50. Last patches purchased was 5 years ago, and they're out. They need 12 EMT patches for new coveralls; rest are Eva VFD patches.
- 5-Ruth asked if Council might authorize the running of a wire down the west wall in her office so that she can plug in a calculator and her weather alert. She has only 1 plug in the office and it is behind her desk. Both plugs in the receptacle are used with telephone and the microphone lines.
- 6-Clerk would like permission to be gone Friday April 28 and Monday May 1 for a trip to New Orleans; and week of July 4 for trip to Eureka Springs, Ark. and Branson, Mo.
