

Minutes of the called meeting of the Eva Town Council held on April 2, 1997, at 3:00 P.M. in the Eva Town Hall. Present: Mayor Livingston, C. C. Mosteller, James Fowler, Clarence Alexander, Bert Collins, and Larry Smith.

After prayer by Mr. Fowler, Mayor advised that new business owners for C. J.'s Video, Connie Puckett, and Dale Haley for Dale's Corner (previously C.J.'s Food Mart) have requested privilege license. Since license are non-transferrable and have been purchased for this business year, council shall decide to accept or decline new owners retaining current license. After discussion, Mr. Alexander made motion to accept the license as written, Mr. Collins second, carried.

Mayor stated that a bid package needed to be prepared for the medical office. After discussion concerning a certified engineer to supervise the construction, Mr. Mosteller make a contact with someone for this purpose.

Mayor advised that cost from Shelby Contracting to pave the lower end of Edgewood Street will cost \$11,000 (this figure does not include the turn-a-round). Mr. Jean Deese has agreed to donate to the Town of Eva the amount for cost of paving. Mayor will get information concerning documentation of this agreement with Mr. Deese. Mr. Fowler made motion for Mayor Livingston to enter a certified written agreement with Jean Deese stating that he will enlarge the turn-a-round or extend the street out to Childers Road from the turn-a-round, Mr. Smith second, carried.

Mayor stated that Lions Club needs an answer concerning a location for the circus they plan to hold to raise funds for community projects. After discussion, Mr. Collins made motion to allow the Eva Lions Club to have a circus in the park if they clean up, Mr. Smith second, carried.

Mayor advised estimate for fence at park by walking trail next to Ricky Wallace's property and Steve Cobb running East and West from Eva Road to Gravel Ridge Road is \$1530.00. Mr. Collins will discuss this price with Ricky Wallace concerning his one-third cost. Council will discuss after that time.

Mayor also advised that Mrs. David Chaffin, owner of Eva Tire location where Eva Automotive (leased by Joe Hall) was recently destroyed by fire, stated that cost for clean-up is approximately \$4,000.00 therefore, they can not financially have this done. Mayor will discuss with county office.

In addition, Mayor advised there is a complaint about chicken liter being used for fertilizing in the town limits and could there be an ordinance against it. After discussion, due to the town being a farming town and many farmers used this product, it would be an undue burden financially on the farmers to pass this ordinance.

Mr. Alexander made motion to adjourn, Mr. Collins second. Carried.
