

Minutes of the Meeting of the Eva Town Council held in regular session on Aug. 14, 1980, at 7 p.m., with the Mayor and Councilmen Mobley, Livingston and Hipps in attendance.

Minutes of the July 10 meeting were read and approved. The financial report giving end-of-July balances was presented as follows:

Councilman Mobley reported that he has the gasoline <sup>tests</sup> tests underway, and he will report back to the Council as soon as the tests are completed.

Councilman Mobley offered the motion, seconded by Mr. Hipps, to pay the bills as follows:

Motion was offered by Mr. Livingston, seconded by Mr. Hipps to transfer \$100 from the General Fund to the Gasoline Tax Fund to cover the amount due on street lights.

It was approved for the Clerk to write a check for the monthly social security tax on the clerk, which is a new requirement that is due in to Montgomery by the 10th of each month. This will not have to be approved at the monthly meetings.

Councilman Page came by the meeting and turned in his letter of resignation as a member of the Town Council effective this date.

The Contract on the 5 home-delivered meals program, which is an addendum to the regular contract for the Eva Nutrition Site, was discussed and approved. The Mayor signed the addendum (2 copies) which will be returned to NARCOG Area Agency on Aging/Mr. Turner.

Mr. Livingston will return to Walker Builders on Saturday the carpet pad and the glue which has been discussed with Seabuck Walker and approved for return.

The mail for the month was discussed and decisions made on the specific items as follows:

- (1) Letter from Morgan County Commission regarding Town of Eva Voters' List - it was voted that this was not a just and due claim; no payment for the list approved.
- (2) Letter from Morgan Family (Dr. Jack Morgan) expressing appreciation for the street sign on Morgan Drive with favorable comments.
- (3) Announcement from Ala. Chapter of Cystic Fibrosis Foundation that will be conducting Fall 1980 campaign in this community between September 8 and Oct. 18, 1980.
- (4) Request from Ala. League of Municipalities for names and addresses of mayor and councilmen. The Clerk will send this in right away. It was decided not to join the Ala. League at this time as members.
- (5) Invitation from Eva Senior Citizens to attend their barbecue as guests on Sept. 5 at 2 p.m. Mayor Ryan and Mr. Hipps gave affirmative replies. The Clerk will check later on others and notify the Senior Citizens Center.

- (6) Invitation to Mayor Ryan to serve on Professional Advisory Committee for PACT. He declined because of so many other commitments at this time.
- (7) Letter from CETA asking if the Town of Eva plans to apply for any CETA workers for next year. It does not; therefore, application will not be returned.

There being no further business, Mr. Livingston offered the motion; seconded by Mr. Hips, that the meeting be adjourned.
