

Minutes of Meeting of Eva Town Council held in regular session August 8, 1985, 7 P.M., attended by Mayor Ryan, Councilmen Page, Nichols and Hipps. Minutes of the July 11 meeting and the July 30 call meeting were read and approved. Financial report was presented as follows:

Old Business:

- 1-Clerk sent letter to Dept. of Mental Health & Retardation giving figures on expenditures in 1984 and amounts budgeted for 1985.
- 2-Nothing has been heard from the Eva School on support requested for School Year 1985-86. Clerk will call to remind Mr. Jones we need this information as soon as possible.

New Business:

- 1-Council voted to send \$250 to the Sheriff's Department for the Narcotics Fund (per budget).
- 2-Voted to increase amount sent to County on Deputy Salary by 5% (from \$10,000 annually to \$10,500 annually), beginning with Oct. payment. (Motion offered by Nichols; second by Page)
- 3-Voted to get County to clean up roadsides and around stop signs in Town of Eva, at a charge, if they are available. Also voted to get County to do repair work around the Post Office and to fill in the ditch down the street from the Post Office, and to fix the corner lot for better parking area.
- 4-Voted to pay the bills as presented and to transfer funds as required. (Motion by Page; second by Nichols). Bills presented were:
